

PRJ in Philippine E-Journals (PEJ)

- PAARL to enter into an "Open Access License to Publish Agreement" with CE-Logic
- PAARL to retain all rights, titles and interest in and to the content or other materials we will be providing to CE-Logic under this agreement
- PAARL and CE-Logic agree that materials shall be posted under a Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 3.0 License:
 - You are free to share and adapt the material provided that you give appropriate credit, you are not to use the material for commercial purposes and you must distribute under the same license as the original
- Open access journals are not entitled to royalties
