A total of 438 individual and 180 institutional members paid their dues. An increase in the number of membership was evident.

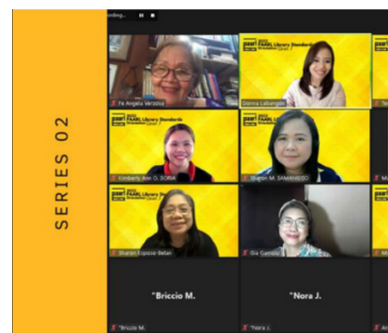
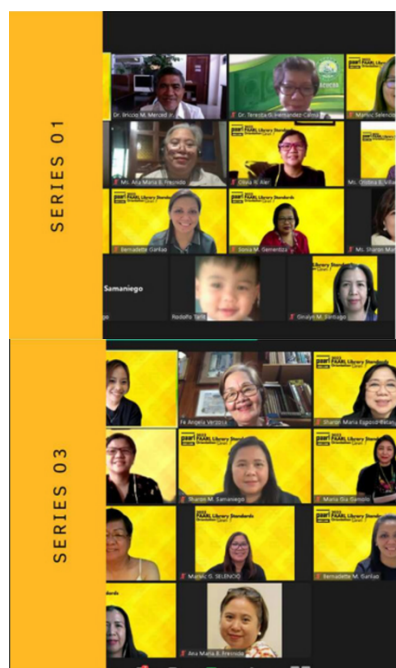
ACTIVITIES

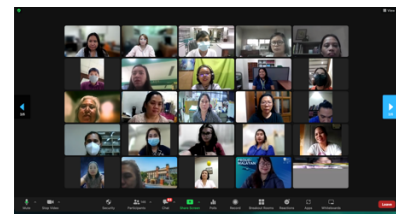
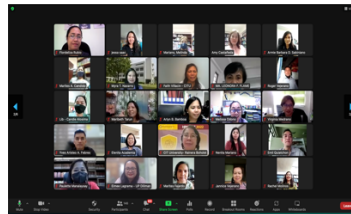
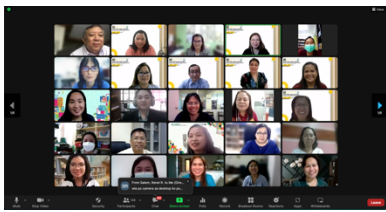
Marina G. Dayrit MLS Workshop 1 and 2



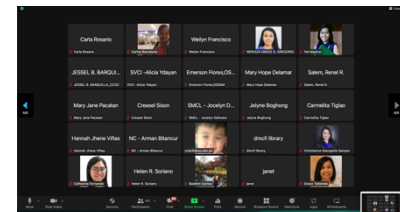
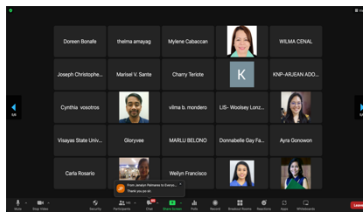
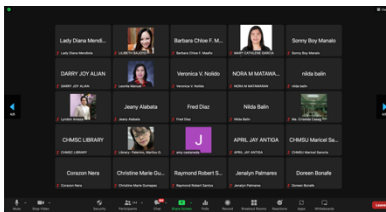
The first and second Marina G. Dayrit MLS Workshop was held via Zoom on June 23-24, 2022 with the theme “Developing Vision, Mission, Goals, and Objectives (VMGO): Setting the Library Roadmap.” The learning outcomes of this workshop are as follows:

- 1) To familiar with the fundamentals of developing the vision, mission, goals, and objectives;
- 2) To know the basic principles of planning aligned with the organization’s vision, mission, goals, objectives, and values;
- 3) To present a draft of the library’s vision, mission, goals, and objectives; and
- 4) To impart the knowledge learned to their respective libraries.

This workshop was approved with 8 PRC CPD points.



A total of 165 participants joined the two-day workshop which was facilitated by Mr. Alfredo F. Diaz, Jr., a human resource practitioner and professional who has worked with local and international companies, schools, as well as government agencies, and local government units.






GENERATION ALPHA

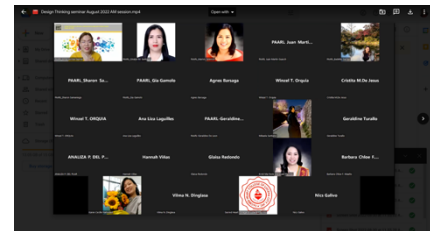
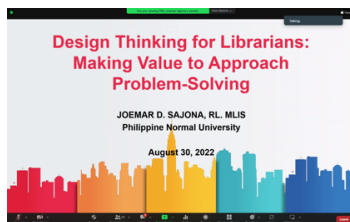


D. Design Thinking for Libraries

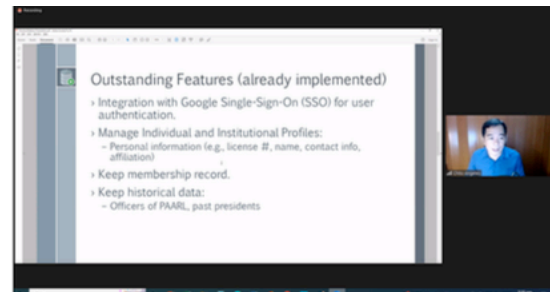
E. 2022 PAARLNet



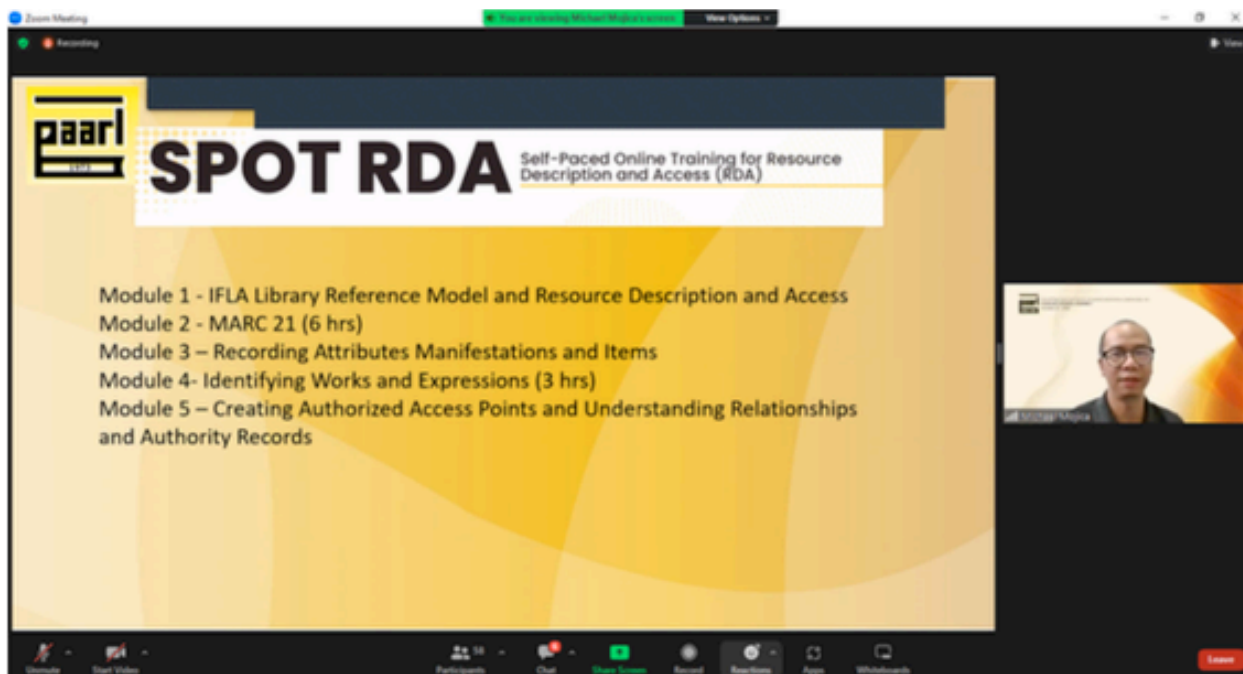

C&E Logic Research Grant

On July 15, 2022, the PAARL Board signed a memorandum of agreement for the renewal of C&E Logic Research Grant at the C&E Information Resource Center. Villarosa, Mr. Eric Eugenio, and Ms. Mary Anne Eugenio. PAARL President, Ms. Sharon M. Samaniego headed the PAARL Team with Dr. Maria Gia G. Gamolo, Ms. Bernadette M. Garilao, Ms. Anna Loriza D. Sajona, and Ms. Marivic G. Selencio.



C&E -Logic supports the research agenda of PAARL through a grant/donation amounting to Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000) per annum; to be awarded during the PAARL Annual General Assembly, or event/venue mutually agreed upon by both parties.

Marina G. Dayrit Memorial Grant

The Marina G. Dayrit grant of Php25,000.00 aims to cover the honorarium expenses for the Marina G. Dayrit Lecture Series. An online meeting with Ms. Rosie G. Dayrit was held in April 2022. The meeting was participated by past president Mr. Michael Anthony A. Mojica.

NCCA-NCLIS Grant

Also in April 2022, the Board received a grant amounting to Php200,000.00 from the National Commission on Culture and the Arts-National Committee on Libraries and Information Science (NCCA-NCLIS). The said grant shall be utilized for the project entitled “Development of Interactive, Self-Paced, Online Training Modules on Resource Description and Access (RDA) for Librarians in the Philippines” which was dubbed as the SPOT on RDA or Self-Paced Online Training on Resource Description and Access.

C&E Logic Zoom Pro accounts

On its second year, CELogic renewed its provision of Zoom Pro accounts to PAARL. With 10 licenses, the Zoom account can host up to 300 participants. Recordings and attendance are also available from the account.



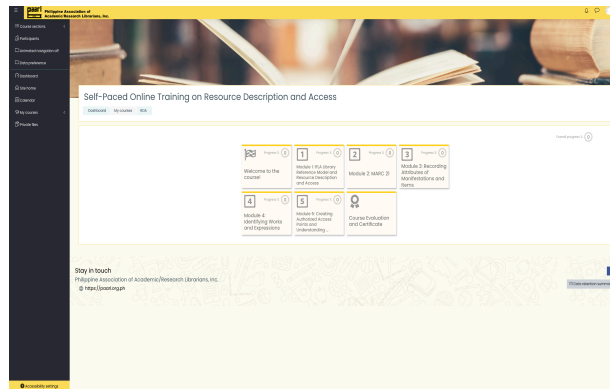
SPOT on RDA

The SPOT on RDA or Self-Paced Online Training on Resource Description and Access a project funded by the National Commission on Culture and the Arts-National Committee on Libraries and Information Science (NCCA-NCLIS) had its initial launch during the PAARLNet General Assembly in October. The online training is a five-module course that aims to build the capacity of Filipino librarians in cataloging using the RDA standard. Since this module is accessible through an LMS, more catalogers in the Philippines will be able to learn how to transition from AACR to RDA.



For the first batch of the training, there were 100 registered participants. A program launch for the training is set on January 31, 2023. The participants will start their self-paced training using

the PAARL LMS i.e. <https://lms.paarl.org.ph/> on January 31, 2023 and shall end on March 31, 2023.



A total of 16 CPD points was granted to this online training. Another batch of training shall be announced soon by the 2023 Board.

PAARL SOHO

The approved proposal during the PAARL 2022 General Assembly on the acquisition of a Small Office Home Office (SOHO) was realized in March 2022. Upon the recommendation of the Ad hoc Committee on PAARL Home Office, the acquisition of the SOHO was made from an inventory of more than a dozen site inspections of various condominium units in Metro Manila. The computation of expenses are as follows:

To be able to fund the acquisition, the PAARL Time Deposit amounting to Php1,305,106.51 was terminated. In addition, withdrawal of funds from the following BDO Accounts was made:

 Rehabilitation Fund (000560295502) – two hundred thousand pesos (200,000.00)
 Reserve Fund (000560345658) – one hundred thirty-three thousand, seven hundred fifty-seven pesos and forty-five centavos (133,757.45)

Some 200,000 pesos were also spent for the purchase of appliances, furnitures, fixtures and office equipment to furnish the SOHO.

UPDATE ON PAARL BANK ACCOUNTS

The PAARL Time Deposit amounting to Php1,305,106.51 was terminated for the purchase of PAARL SOHO. BPI PAARL Scholarship Fund (005953339597) amounting to seven hundred fifty-three thousand, eight hundred sixty-five pesos and thirty centavos (753,865.30) was also closed because it bears an account name that is not registered with SEC and the bank required corporate papers to be able to withdraw funds from it. It was created in 2010 by Past President Christopher C. Paras. Fortunately, the bank manager allowed the transfer of the funds to our Maxi Checking Account after some papers documenting the transaction made by Mr. Paras were presented as proof that the funds were part of PAARL as the only registered corporation by that name.
